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

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
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**Allowable Uses**

**IN PERSON INSTRUCTION**

- In person instruction grants may be used for any purpose consistent with providing in-person instruction for any pupil participating in in-person instruction
- Community learning hubs

**TECHNOLOGY**

- Purchasing educational technology (including hardware, software and connectivity)

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### Allowable Uses (Continued)

#### PLANNING & COORDINATION

- Coordination and preparedness of response with public health.

#### LEARNING LOSS

- Activities that directly support pupil academic achievement & mitigate learning loss related to COVID-19 school closures
- Address learning loss by administering & using high quality assessments that are valid and reliable
- Address learning loss by implementing evidence-based activities to meet the comprehensive needs of students
- Address learning loss by providing information & assistance to parents & families on how they can effectively support students.

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### Allowable Uses (Continued)

- Address learning loss or accelerating progress to close learning gaps thru learning supports before the start of the school year and into the school year.
- Supports for credit deficient pupils to complete graduation or grade promotion requirements and to increase or improve pupils' college eligibility.
- Extending instructional school year or take any other action that increases the amount of instructional time/services provided based on student's learning needs.

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### Allowable Uses (Continued)

- Planning & implementing activities related to summer learning and supplemental afterschool programs, including providing classroom instruction or online learning during the summer months and addressing the needs of vulnerable student groups.
- Providing additional academic services for pupils, such as diagnostic assessments of pupil learning needs, intensive instruction for addressing gaps in core academic skills, additional instructional materials or supports, or devices or connectivity for the provision of in-classroom and distance learning.

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### Allowable Uses (Continued)

#### OTHER SUPPORTS

- Provide integrated supports to address learning barriers & training to teachers & parents, access to school meals, or socio-emotional programs.
- Activities to address unique needs of low-income students, students with disabilities, English learners, racial & ethnic minorities, homeless & foster youth
- Providing mental health services and supports

#### STAFF

- Salaries for staff providing In-Person Instruction or services.

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### Allowable Uses (Continued)

- Educator training in accelerated learning strategies and addressing learning gaps.
- Training for school staff on trauma informed practices.
- Training and professional development for staff of the local educational agency on sanitation and minimizing the spread of infectious diseases.

#### OPERATIONS & FACILITIES

- Purchasing supplies to sanitize and clean facilities.
- COVID-19 testing

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### Allowable Uses (Continued)

- Addressing health & safety concerns, including, but not limited to, purchasing public health testing, PPE, supplies to sanitize and clean facilities and school buses of an LEA, and for other related needs.
- School facility repairs & improvements to enable operation of schools to reduce risk of virus transmission & exposure to environmental health hazards, & to support student health needs.
- Inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, replacement, & upgrade projects to improve the indoor air quality in school facilities, including mechanical & non-mechanical heating, ventilation & air conditioning systems, filtering, purification & other air cleaning fans, control systems, & window & door repair & replacement.
